## This funding will be used to

- Achieve 100% of students reaching a C standard in English in Year 7.
- Increase students reaching a C standard in English from 65% to 90% in Year 8.
- Maintain students reaching a C standard in English at 100% in Year 9.
- Increase students reaching a C standard in English from 91% to 100% in Year 10.
- Increase % of Year 7 students meeting NMS in reading from 91% to 100%.
- Increase % of Year 7 students in the U2B in reading from 16% to 20%.
- Maintain % of Year 9 students meeting NMS in reading at 100%
- Increase the % of Year 9 students in the U2B in reading from 16% to 20%.
- Increase the % of Year 7 students meeting NMS in writing from 83% to 90%
- Increase % of Year 7 students in the U2B in writing from 8% to 16%.
- Increase the % of Year 9 students meeting NMS in writing from 88% to 100%.
- Increase % of Year 9 students in the U2B in writing from 5% to 10%.

## Our initiatives include

- Developing a whole school approach to the teaching and learning of literacy.
- Improving teacher capacity through targeted professional development and instructional coaching.
- Improving teacher aide capacity to support student learning through targeted professional development.
- Improving student outcomes in literacy through targeted teaching and learning.
- Implementing short- and long-term data cycles to analyse student progress and inform teaching and learning.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Investing in targeted professional development to build Principal, HOD, teacher and teacher aide capacity in the leading, teaching and learning of literacy.
- Investing in a teaching and Learning HOD position to lead a whole school approach to the teaching and learning of literacy, provide targeted professional development and coaching for teachers and analyse data to monitor progress and inform teaching and learning.
- Investing in additional teacher aide time in order to support the teaching and learning of literacy.
