**Under this agreement for 2018
Collinsville State High School will receive**

\$71,840*

This funding will be used to:

- Improve student outcomes across the curriculum, with a particular focus on writing, to reach the following targets:
 - 100% of students achieving above National Minimum Standards (NMS) in Years 7 and 9 for Writing
 - 20% of students achieving in the Upper Two Bands (U2B) in Year 7 for Writing
 - 25% of students achieving in the U2B in Year 9 for Writing
 - 500 Mean Scale Score (MSS) in Year 7 for Writing
 - 540 MSS in Year 9 for Writing
 - 85% of students achieving an A-C result in English, Mathematics, Science and Humanities in Years 7 to 10
 - 40% of students achieving an A-B result English, Mathematics, Science and Humanities in Years 7 to 10
 - 100% of eligible students achieving a QCE in Year 12
 - 100% of eligible students achieving an OP of 1 to 15 in Year 12.

Our initiatives include:

- developing a whole school approach to the teaching and learning of writing
- improving teacher capacity to implement writing in the curriculum, using “Getting Kids Writing: One Sentence at a Time” and the Literacy Continuum, through targeted professional development and instructional coaching
- improving student outcomes in writing through targeted teaching and learning, and identifying the writing demands across the curriculum
- improving student outcomes in reading through targeted intervention
- improving student literacy and numeracy outcomes through additional support in core classes
- implementing short- and long-term data cycles to analyse student progress and inform teaching and learning.
